- ★ Cambridgeshire Young Persons Awards (CYPHA)

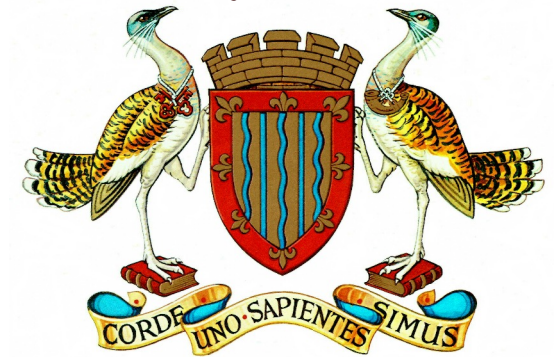

CAMBRIDGESHIRE ASSOCIATION FOR LOCAL HISTORY WHO ARE WE AND WHAT DO WE DO?

We were founded in 1951 as the **Cambridgeshire Local History Council**, at a time just after WW2 when so many ancient records were lost and when there was concern at the lack of local and social history provision in the outlying villages of the county. In 1983, to reflect the time, the organisation's name was changed to the **Cambridgeshire Local History Society**.

In 2006, to restate the organisation's founding principles and to highlight its umbrella role representing the county's societies and clubs, (a role we take very seriously indeed), we changed our name to the **Cambridgeshire Association for Local History**

One of our principle aims is to encourage and support the study of local, social and family history in Cambridgeshire. We also encourage members to transcribe records and carry out research on their own or with others and to make the results available in our annual **Review** as well as elsewhere. We are always willing to help and advise, as well as keep Cambridgeshire's vibrant local and family history community informed of all the local and national news

We hold monthly lectures, usually in Cambridge, from October to May. Speakers cover a wide and fascinating range of subjects. Individual and family members can attend lectures free, while members of our corporate societies will be asked to pay just £1 each. Guests and non-members are more than welcome to attend for an entrance fee of £2.50 per lecture.

In April, we hold our annual conference, and in May we hold our annual gathering and history awards; both of these are held in an outlying Cambridgeshire village or town. In the summer months, we arrange an extensive range of excursions and visits to places of historical interest both locally and further afield
