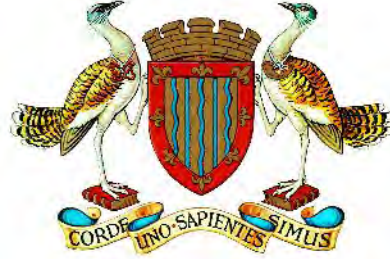

- Work is welcomed from both Individuals or Groups & can include those who have carried out the work as part of another scheme such as the Duke of Edinburgh Award, etc.
- Work must be have been carried out in the last two years
- Work must be have been carried out when aged 16 years or younger
- All abilities are welcome
