The Society was founded in 1840 to promote both the study of history, architectural history, and archaeology and the conservation of relevant features and objects, within the county of Cambridgeshire particularly. Members are entitled to free access to our lectures (to which university undergraduates and members' guests are welcome), reduced fee for our spring conference, a free copy of PCAS and access to a specialist archaeological library. Excursions are also arranged.

Our monthly lectures and the day conferences are normally held in the Law Faculty, Cambridge University Sidwick site, except for the joint meeting with the Cambridgeshire Association for Local History and the Ladd's Lecture. There is some free parking available.

Lectures start at 6.00 pm (unless otherwise indicated) and last for about an hour with an opportunity for questions and discussion afterwards.

Membership is open to anyone interested in any aspect of local history, archaeology, or architecture. The annual subscription is £12.50 for Ordinary Membership, £15 for Families or Affiliated Societies membership and £20 Subscribing Institution.
