Chatteris Museum collection was started in the 1940's by Charles Dobb, Clerk to the Council, and officially opened as a museum in 1963 in Grove House. In 1995 the collection was packed up and moved to Church Lane. Gradually we are building up the displays to reflect the history of Chatteris from earliest times to present day.
