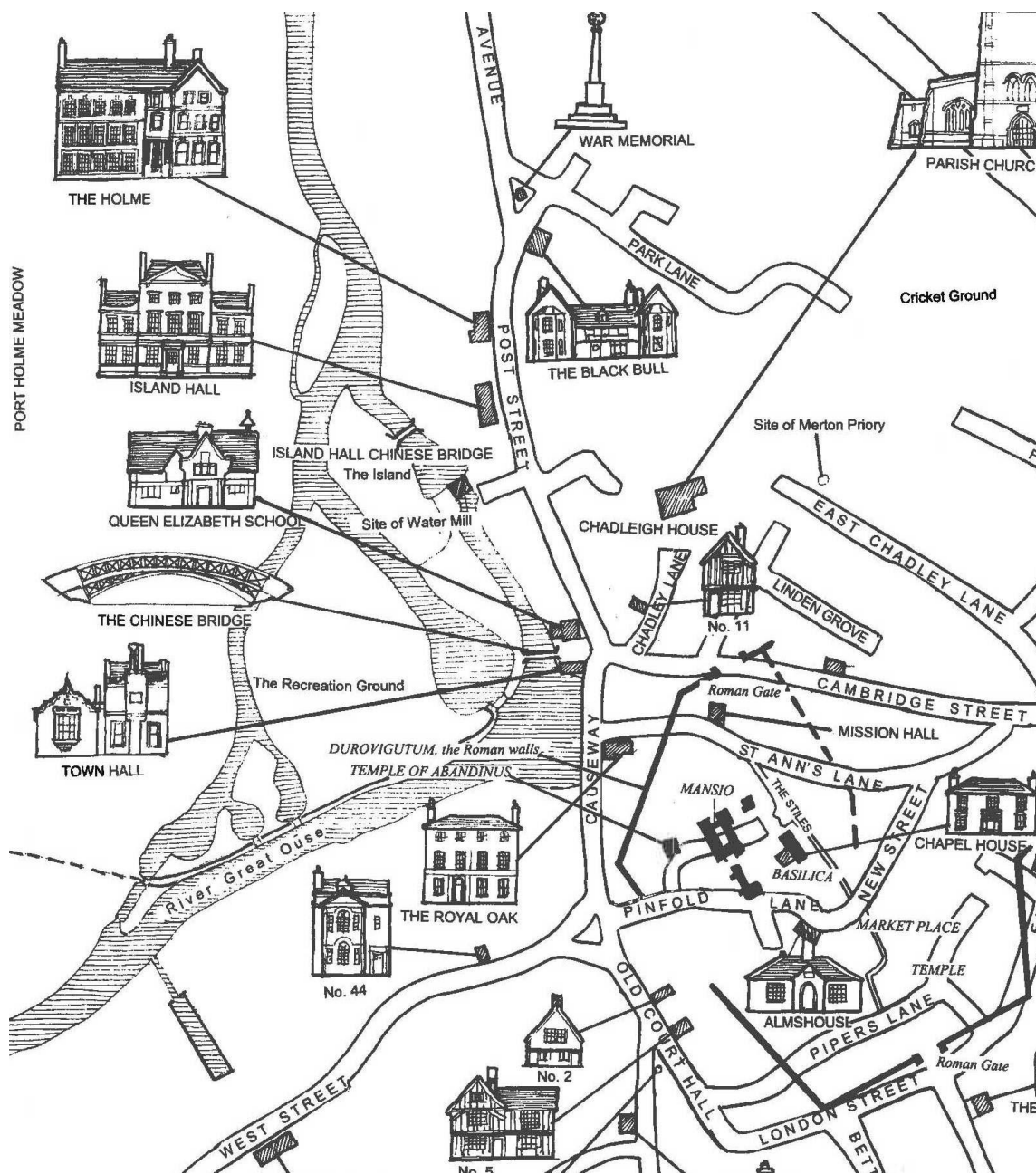
There will be ample opportunity for discussion and questions at the end of each session.
