The Ramsey Rural Museum is an independent Museum situated in Huntingdonshire which is staffed, run, and managed entirely by Volunteers. The Museum is housed in 17th century buildings which originally formed part of the wood yard of the Fellowes Estate. The collection consists of vintage agricultural machinery, which has been lovingly restored by the volunteers, together with a Chemist, Cobblers, Village Shop and a Victorian Kitchen, Bedroom and Living Room. In addition to all of these there are many artefacts chronicling the social history of the area over the past 150 years. We also house a large archive which includes censuses and many other records which could be of use to anyone researching their families who may have lived in the area.
