The society exists to foster interests and research in family history in Royston and surrounding villages. Lying as it does on the edge of Hertfordshire, Essex and Cambridgeshire, none of the traditional county-based family history societies quite met the founders' interests in Royston and its hinterland, so a specific society was formed to meet these interests. Starting from a small group of 12 members in 1987 the society had grown slowly to its present size.

We meet on the third Monday of the month (except August) in the Community Hall of All Saints Church in the centre of Melbourn – just off the High Street at the centre of the village. Meetings are open to all: we ask non-members for a £2 contribution to refreshments and to help pay the cost of hall hire.

Membership is £8 (single UK), £9 (single overseas) or £10.50 (family: two or more persons at the same address and receiving a single copy if the journal). Members receive a copy of the journal and reduced price entry to meetings.
