The Thorney Society is a registered charity (298235), set up in 1985, which runs the Thorney Heritage Museum. The object of the Society is to encourage interest in, and knowledge of, the local and natural history of the village and parish of Thorney, and to maintain the Museum for the interest and education of local people and visitors. It also runs social and educational events, and raises money to support the Museum. Meetings are held at least one a year, typically at the Bedford Hall, Thorney, or Thorney Abbey.

The Society is concerned with local history, natural history and the promotion of good practice in local planning. The Museum is open to the public on Sundays from Easter until the end of September, and to other people and groups by arrangement. www.thorney-museum.org.uk
