

Stagecoach 7, from Emmanuel Street Stop E1, alighting in Sawston at either the war memorial or Tannery Road (both about 5 mins walk, Tannery Road slightly nearer).

Buses leave Emmanuel Street at 09.10, arriving in Sawston 09.45 or 09.30 arriving in Sawston 10.05.

Return buses at 16.06, 16.26 and 16.56.


Car Parking
